- Each programme involves 48 days funded release over 12 months
- Release supported by grant payment to your employer
- Linked with an experienced research-active supervisor(s) throughout.

- Involves attendance at an academic writing course

Internship Programme

Complete a M level module to develop your research knowledge and skills, and prepare you for masters level research training.

Pre-Doctoral Bridging Programme

This bespoke programme is designed to enable you to submit a doctoral application and enhance your research skills and profile, and complete leadership development.

Post-Doctoral Bridging Programme

Will bridge the gap between doctorate and applying for a post-doctoral training award. You will be supported and coached to design a programme of research, build your research support team, and develop your skills as an independent researcher and future mentor. There is up to £14,000 funding available to support you with your release and development during the programme.
