RISK FACTORS FOR SEPSIS INCLUDE:

- Age > 75
- Impaired immunity (e.g. diabetes, steroids, chemotherapy)
- Recent trauma / surgery / invasive procedure
- Indwelling lines / IVDU / broken skin

O3 ANY RED FLAG PRESENT

- Objective evidence of new or altered mental state
- Systolic BP ≤ 90 mmHg (or drop of > 40 from normal)
- Heart rate ≥ 130 per minute
- Respiratory rate ≥ 25 per minute
- Needs O2 to keep SpO2 ≥ 92% (88% in COPD)
- Non-blanching rash/mottled/ ashen/cyanotic
- Lactate ≥ 2 mmol/l

NO

- Recent chemotherapy
- Not passed Urine in 18 hours (<0.5ml/kg/hr if catheterised)

RED FLAG SEPSIS START SEPSIS SIX

ANY AMBER

U4 FLAG PRESENT

- Relatives concerned about mental status
- Acute deterioration in functional ability
- Immunosuppressed
- Trauma / surgery/ procedure in the last 8 weeks
- Respiratory rate 21 24
- Systolic BP 91 100 mmHg
- Heart rate 91 130 or new dysrhythmia
- Temperature < 36c
- Clinical sign of wound infection

FURTHER REVIEW REQUIRED

- Send bloods and review
- Ensure senior clinical review within 1hr
