Dear Resident/Business Owner

We've been working hard to safely bring the Great Birmingham Run back to the city, and after 2 years, we can't wait to see thousands of runners take on their 10k or Half Marathon challenge on Sunday 1 May.

For the first time both events are taking place on the same day, along with the Junior & Mini event.

Birmingham City Council, in conjunction with The Great Run Company are organising the Great Birmingham Run – a half marathon and 10km – starting at 0930. The event expects to attract thousands of runners. The run will start and finish on Jennens Rd, in the city centre. This mass participation event is aimed at getting more people, more active, more regularly.

Before and during the run, it will be necessary to implement a number of road closures along the route from 04:00. These have been agreed with Birmingham City Council and will be implemented in a number of phases (closures between 04:00 – 08:30 and reopenings between 12:00 and 19:00).

Please note that the route is very similar to our 2019 plans when the event was last staged in Birmingham, but please revisit the map and familiarise yourself with the route and roads affected – as things have changed a little.

The road closures will NOT affect the access of emergency vehicles. The roads affected are detailed in the table on this leaflet. For further detailed information please go to greatrun.org/Birmingham.

Reopening of roads will be done in a structured manner following the last runners in the event. Event infrastructure will be removed and roads cleansed ahead of reopening.

We understand that the road closures will cause some inconvenience. Please plan journeys in advance and allow for additional time as the road network will be busy. Where possible, it would be appreciated if cars can be parked on driveways or on side streets. We will have an uplift system in place on event day to relocate vehicles left on the route. Vehicles removed could be subject to a penalty charge notice so we kindly ask that you remove vehicles before closures come into effect.

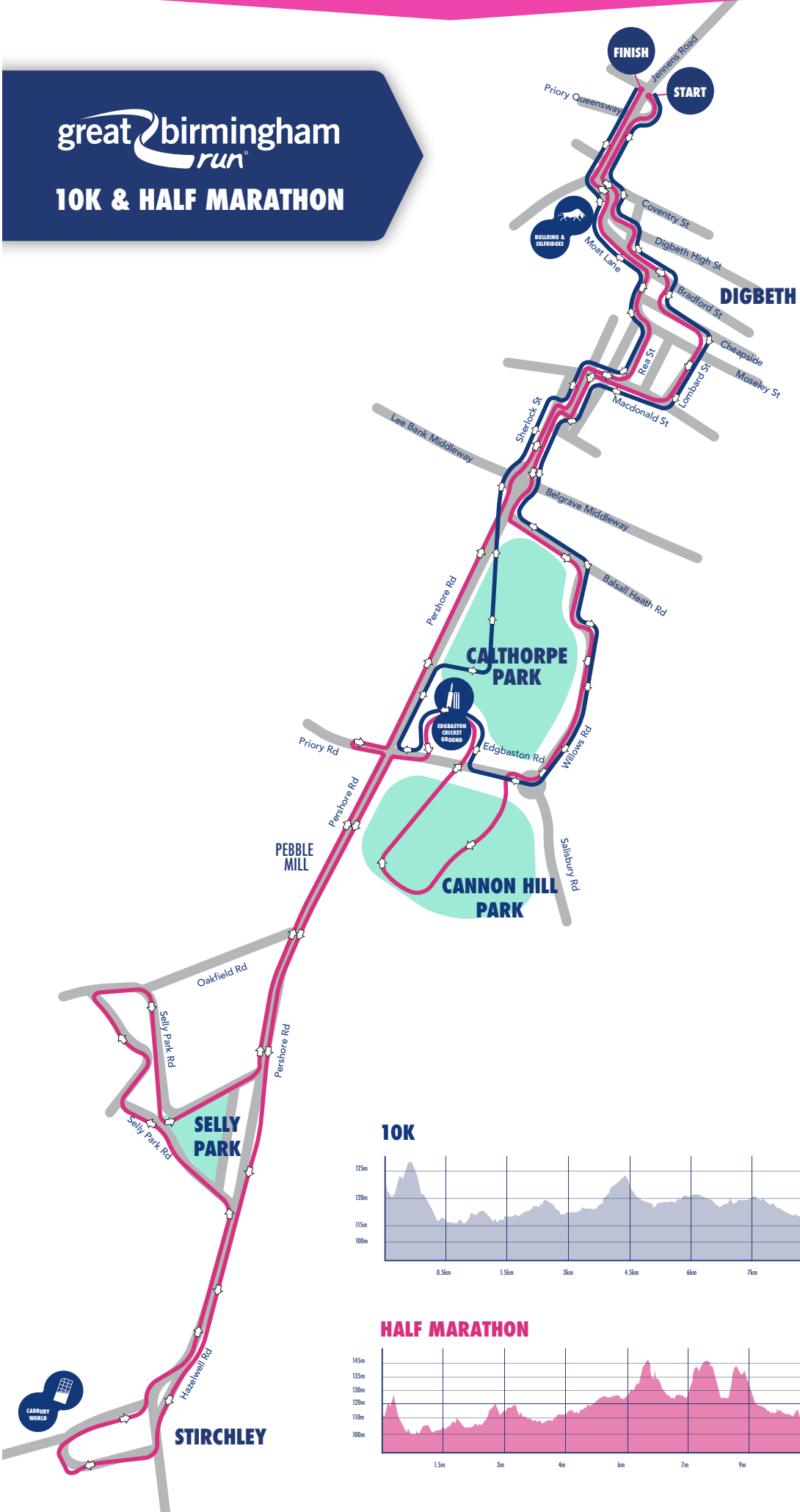
The Great Birmingham Run will endeavour to minimise disruption to the road network and ensure roads are returned to normal traffic conditions in a timely fashion.

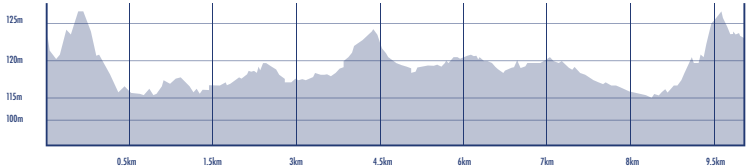
