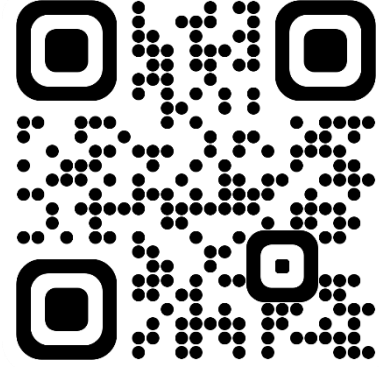

## PRAYER FOR VAISHNAVI

Om tryāmbakaṃ yajāmahe sugandhīṃ puṣṭi-vardhānam  
urvārukamīva bandhānān mṛtyor mukṣīya mā'mṛtāt

This prayer pays tribute to Lord Shiva, and is one of Vaishnavi's favourites. It roughly translates as having taken birth in such a world of illusions, albeit temporarily, let me bloom as a flower and spread fragrance and grow up in the nourishment given by the earth like the gourd that seems so strongly attached to its stem, but detaches itself when it has grown fully.

Upon fulfilling my purpose on the earth, let me be freed of all the bondage like the gourd, and in my demise, may I be liberated from all attachments, as I ask not for deathlessness, but for liberation from all attachments.
