

# **DRUG SAFETY NOTICE**

#### DRUG NAME/STRENGTH/FORM:

# Glucagon 0.5mg and 1mg

# **PROBLEM**

- GlucaGen® 1mg powder for injection kit will be unavailable from mid-June until to mid-July 2023 at which point normal supply is expected to resume.
- There are two glucagon preparations available
  - GlucaGen® (1mg powder for injection kit)
  - o Ogluo® (0.5mg and 1mg pre-filled auto-injector pens)

## **ADVICE / ALTERNATIVE**

- Ogluo® 0.5mg and 1mg pre-filled auto-injector pens can be used for the treatment of severe hypoglycaemic episodes
  - o It is not suitable for treatment of beta blocker or other drug overdoses.
- Keep in mind Ogluo stocks will be shortdated 31<sup>st</sup> July
- Glucagen to be used after this date
- Ogluo® (pre-filled auto-injector pen containing solution) only licensed to be given subcutaneously.

## **ACTIONS**

06 June 2023

- Prioritise Ogluo for Hypoglycaemia
- Glucagen stocks to be reserved for use after short dated Ogluo stocks depleted
- Beta blockers or other overdoses to be treated with High Dose Insulin treatment as recommended by Toxbase - <u>Glucagon (Toxbase.org)</u>
