



DRUG SAFETY NOTICE

Potential for inappropriate dosing of insulin when switching insulin degludec (Tresiba®) products

PROBLEM

- A <u>Medicine Supply Notification</u> issued on 24 May 2023, detailed a shortage of Tresiba® (insulin degludec) FlexTouch® <u>100units/mL</u> solution for injection 3ml prefilled pens.
- Some patients may have been switched to Tresiba® (insulin degludec) FlexTouch®
 200units/mL solution for injection 3ml pre-filled pens.
- A small number of patients have been incorrectly advised to administer half the number of units.

ADVICE / ALTERNATIVE

• Tresiba® FlexTouch® devices dial up in unit increments rather than volume.

ACTIONS

SWB does not stock Tresiba® (insulin degludec) FlexTouch® 200units/ml solution for injection 3ml pre-filled pens however some patients may have been switched to this product by their GP or Diabetes team

- Patients who have been switched to Tresiba® (insulin degludec) FlexTouch®
 200units/mLsolution for injection 3mL pre-filled pen MUST be made aware that Tresiba® FlexTouch® pen delivery devices,
 - o dial up in unit increments rather than volume.
 - no dose change is necessary.
- Avoid initiating patients on Tresiba® (insulin degludec) FlexTouch® <u>200units/mL</u> prefilled pens as these are not able to support increased demand while the <u>100units/mL</u> solution for injection 3mL pre-filled pens are out of stock.
- Tresiba® penfill cartridges can be considered as an alternative taking into account:
 - Patient dexterity and ability to use the device correctly and:
 - The appropriate delivery system and needles are available and provided to the patient i.e., the non-disposable NovoPen 6 which will have 1 unit increments similar to the disposable FlexTouch pens.
- Patients are counselled on the change in device and provided with training on their use and potential need for closer blood glucose monitoring.





- If changing to Tresiba 100units/ml Penfill®

 cartridges is inappropriate seek advice from the specialist diabetes team on use of an alternative insulin
- All clinicians to be aware of the above information seeking advice from the diabetes team as required.
- Ensure all patients prescribed the penfill cartridges have the NovoPen 6 delivery system and are counselled and trained to use the device appropriately. The NovoPen 6 delivery system is available from the Trust diabetes team.
