



DRUG SAFETY NOTICE

Supply Disruption

DRUG NAME/STRENGTH/FORM:

Salbutamol 2.5mg/2.5ml and 5mg/2.5ml nebules

PROBLEM

- Salbutamol 2.5mg/2.5ml and 5mg/2.5ml nebuliser liquid is in very limited supply with a resolution date to be confirmed.
- Unlicensed supplies of salbutamol 2.5mg/2.5ml and 5mg/2.5ml nebuliser liquid have been sourced, lead times vary.

ADVICE

Where salbutamol nebules 2.5mg/5ml and 5mg/5ml are unavailable please follow the below order

- 1. Use unlicensed salbutamol 2.5mg and 5mg nebs if available
- 2. Use Terbutaline (Bricanyl) 5mg/2ml nebs in due to come in this Friday 23/02/24 afternoon to cover only 30 packs.
- 3. Use Salbutamol MDI via spacer device (spacer with adult mask is available) 25 puffs = 2.5mg dose.
- 4. Use Salbutamol IV
- 5. Use Salbutamol injection via nebuliser unlicensed last resort

BTS/SIGN guidance recommends that in patients with mild to moderate asthma attacks, beta2-agonists can be administered by repeated activations of a pressurised metered dose inhaler via an appropriate large volume spacer. In acute-severe or life-threatening asthma, beta2-agonists should be administered by nebulisation.

ACTIONS

- Once licensed has returned do not use unlicensed stock
- Refer to the BNF and BNFc for sull prescribing guidelines
