Supply Update

DRUG NAME/STRENGTH/FORM:

Trurapi 100 units/ml solution for injection pre-filled pen

- SWB will be initiating Trurapi[®] in place of NovoRapid[®] for new patients.
- If clinically appropriate, patients may be switched from NovoRapid[®] to Trurapi[®]
- Trurapi and Novorapid are not interchangeable!

ALTERNATIVE

- Trurapi[®] is an insulin aspart biosimilar manufactured by Sanofi.
- Trurapi[®] has a 30% lower NHS list price vs. NovoRapid[®] pre-filled pens and cartridges and 15% lower NHS list price vs. NovoRapid[®] vials.

ADVICE

- Similar PK/PD profiles (T1DM), efficacy, safety, and tolerability (T1DM and T2DM)⁹⁻¹⁰
- Trurapi[®] (insulin aspart) is supported for local use and recommended as the preferred brand of insulin aspart in place of NovoRapid[®] for new patients in view of the cost to the NHS.
- The Trurapi[®] pre-filled pen is a SoloStar device (the same as all other Sanofi devices).
- Trurapi[®] is also available in vials and cartridges. Please see SPCs for further details.
- All insulin products must be prescribed by brand name.
- Trurapi[®] is different in colour to NovoRapid[®]
- Trurapi[®] and NovoRapid[®] cartridges are different sizes so are not interchangeable.
- The Trurapi cartridges should only be used with the following pens:
 - JuniorSTAR which delivers Trurapi in 0.5-unit dose increments.
 - \circ AllStar PRO which delivers Trurapi in 1.0-unit dose increments.
- Transferring a patient from NovoRapid to Trurapi can be done unit-to-unit based on the previous fast-acting insulin dose.
- Monitoring requirements are the same as with NovoRapid[®]
 - When transferring from other insulin medicinal products, adjustment of the Trurapi[®] dose and the dose of the basal insulin may be necessary. Trurapi[®] has a faster onset and a shorter duration of action than soluble human insulin. Close glucose monitoring is recommended during the transfer and in the initial weeks thereafter.
- NovoRapid[®] will appear as Trurapi[®] on Unity.

ACTIONS

- Refer to the BNF and BNFc for full prescribing guidelines.
- All new patients requiring insulin aspart should be initiated on Trurapi[®]
- If clinically appropriate, patients may be switched from NovoRapid® to Trurapi®



• Patients who are attending for an annual review as an opportunistic switch where clinically appropriate.


